Cabernet Sauvignon 2021



Barricas: These wines are produced with hand-harvested grapes from Tunuyan and Tupungato, Mendoza, one of Argentina's top wine regions. These fun and young wines are focused on balance, elegance and varietal typicity (accurate expression of each variety's characteristic aromas and flavors).

Tasting notes: Deep red color with gently spiced dark red fruits on the nose. The mouth is round with hints of vanilla and chocolate. Medium body and soft tannins make this Cabernet Sauvignon a perfect anytime wine.

Appellation: Uco Valley (Tunuyan), Mendoza, Argentina

Grapes: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Soil: Generally alluvial with a clay/rock base and sandy stony surface.
