Barricas: These wines are produced with hand-harvested grapes from Tunuyan and Tupungato, Mendoza, one of Argentina's top wine regions. These fun and young wines are focused on balance, elegance and varietal *typicity* (accurate expression of each variety's characteristic aromas and flavors).

Tasting notes: Vivid purple varietal wine is round and medium bodied. It has boysenberry and cherry aromas, with hints of violets and vanilla. In the mouth it is round and friendly, with fine tannins notes and a charming finish. Barricas Malbec is one of the best values we have found in Argentina.

Winemaker: Jose Hinojosa Appellation: Uco Valley (Tunuyan), Mendoza, Argentina Grapes: 100% Malbec Soil: Generally alluvial with a clay/rock base and sandy stony surface. Elevation: 4,000 ft Vineyard practice: Dry farming. Hand harvested. Harvest Dates: March Fermentation: Temperature controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks and cement pools. No oak aging.

Tunuyan, Mendoza: Tunuyan is considered by most experts as one of the best regions in the world for growing Malbec grapes. At an altitude of 4000 feet, with pure and clean water from the Andes mountains, varietals like Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec thrives producing excellent wines with expressive fruit and complex structure.
