Finca Don Carlos has been crafting outstanding artisanal wines since 2003. Located in Tupungato region of the Uco Valley, at 3,300 feet above sea level, the vineyards enjoy ideal soil and climate conditions for wine growing.

Winemaker Gustavo Silvestri and Winegrower Patricia Conte work together in growing some of the finest grapes at the 50 hectares planted in the property and making outstanding and expressive wines that are true to their grape varieties and that reflect the unique characteristics of their terroir. With a total capacity of 116,000 liters, the winery is equipped with temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks and state-of-the-art equipment.

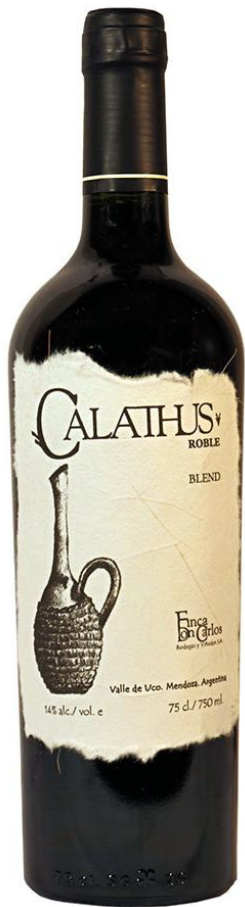

Tasting Notes: Intense violet and red color. Lively aromas of mature red cherries, plums, figs, with mild notes of lavender and cacao. Medium-bodied and well rounded. Multiple layers of flavors well integrated with smooth but gripping tannins and a charming long finish.
