Tasting Notes

Hinojosa Malbec has an intense red color with bluish tones. In the nose it is filled with blueberries, plums and violets. Once in the mouth it has a medium bodied and well balanced. Good acidity with flavors of boysenberries, vanilla and smoky notes. This Malbec goes well with red meats, poultry and soft cheeses.

Ideal serving temperature: 65° - 68° F.

Elaboration Process

Hand picked grapes. Harvest on the 2nd and 3rd week of March. Temperature controlled fermentation. Aged in oak for 6 months.
