## **Tasting Notes**

Hinojosa Malbec has an intense red color with bluish tones. In the nose it is filled with blueberries, plumbs and violets. Once in the mouth it has a medium bodied and well balanced. Good acidity with flavors of boysenberries, vanilla and smoky notes. This Malbec goes well with red meats, poultry and soft cheeses.

Ideal serving temperature: 65 ° - 68° F.

## **Elaboration Process**

Hand picked grapes. Harvest on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> week of March. Temperature controlled fermentation. Aged in oak for 6 months.
