Mythic Winery: In the Southern Hemisphere lies a viticultural Eden bathed by an ancient ridge, where pristine glacial waters filter naturally through nutrient rich earth. This unspoiled paradise is the chosen land for growing vines. It is here where out wines are born. 300 days of sun, deep roots and alluvial soils create the most ideal conditions for these Mythic Argentine wines.

Tasting notes: Deep red color with great aromatic expression with notes of black fruit and spices. In the mouth, its round tannin is highlighted by ripe red fruits.

Medium intensity, fresh and balanced

Grapes: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon Soil: Layers of clay, stones and sand

Elevation: 3,181 ft

Vine Age: 11-70 years old Yield: 2-3 tons per acre Harvest Dates: April Fermentation: The grapes are carefully destemmed and undergo a four-day cold maceration. The must is fermented at low temperatures (26°C) so that in this way greater aromatic delicacy is achieved. The fermentation is completed with soft and delicate pump overs.

Aging: 3 months in 100% French oak barrels

pH: 3.75 RS: 1.8 grams per liter Alc: 13.9% UPC: 8 40087 10041 1

D.O. Penedes: With the Pyrenees mountains in the north, the Bardenas Reales desert in the south, and the Bay of Biscayne (San Sebastian) one hour away, an interesting confluence of 3 climates is created; Atlantic, Continental and Mediterranean traveling north to south. This combined with a range of soils, altitude, sunshine and rainfall all packed into an area of 120 miles north to south and 60 miles east to west, allows for this small region to produce a variety of wine styles all from many different varieties. Very few wine regions can offer this level of quality in white, rose and dessert, under one viticultural area.
