## Rosé 2021



**Bodegas Ochoa:** Today 5<sup>th</sup> generation Javier Ochoa has passed the torch to the 6<sup>th</sup> generation; his two daughters Adriana Ochoa and Beatriz Ochoa. Adriana has done extensive training and winemaking in Bordeaux and Australia and has been awarded 'Best Young Female Winemaker in Spain' by several Spanish and British wine magazines and with the momentum of her father's work pushes Bodega Ochoa forward with the help of her sister Beatriz who manages marketing and sales. Their 145 acres of vineyards and olive orchards are currently being converted to organic agriculture.

**Calendas:** The Calendas range represents a fresh, fruit-forward, young wine. The 'calendas' starts when the vine begins its first bud and dictates the rest of the year.

**Tasting notes:** Wild strawberries and raspberries on the aroma that break out into ample flavor in the mouth with balanced-acidity and a refreshing finish.

**Appellation:** DO Navarra

**Grapes:** 75% Grenacha, 25% Tempranillo

**Soil:** The El Bosque vineyard with Calcareous clay

**Elevation:** 1,312 ft

**Vineyard practice:** South facing vines, guaranteeing good sun exposure that reduces the need of treatments in the vines, allowing viticulture that respects the environment.

**Vine Age:** 25+ years      **Yield:** 3 tons per acre      **Harvest Dates:** September

**Fermentation:** Saignée rosé method. Low temperature Fermentation at 60.8°F with native yeast.

**pH:** 3.32      **RS:** 0.5 gram per liter      **Alc:** 13%      **UPC:** 7 50428 17107 2



**D.O. Navarra:** With the Pyrenees mountains in the north, the Bardenas Reales desert in the south, and the Bay of Biscay just one hour away, creates an interesting confluence of 3 climates; Atlantic, Continental, and Mediterranean. This combined with a range of soils, altitude, sunshine, and rainfall that are all packed into an area of 120 miles north to south and 60 miles east to west, allows for this small region to produce a variety of wine styles from many different varieties. Very few regions can offer this level of quality in white, rose and dessert wines all in one viticultural area.
