Pinot Grigio 2020



History: Founded by Baron Lajos Babos in the 1930's, the winery was named after Oswald of Northumbria, the Patron Saint of the small hamlet where the winery lies in Loncon di Annone Veneto. The winery was purchased by the Serena family in 2004, where they have continued the love and dedication to the land and its vines that Babos started a half century before.

Tasting notes: Lively aromas and flavors of tropical fruits, pear and citrus. Smooth and delicate mouthfeel with balanced acidity and a lingering finish.

Appellation: D.O.C. Delle Venezie

Varietals: 100% Pinot Grigio

Soil: Sandstone and limestone with alternating layers of alluvial and moraine

Vine Age: 20 years

Harvest: Towards the end of September

Fermentation: Temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless-steel tanks.

RS: 3 g/l **Alc:** 12.5 % **UPC:** 8005595023030

D.O.C Delle Venezie: Established as a DOC since 2017, it's one of Italy's best-known designations for Pinot Grigio and comprises the regions of Veneto, Friuli-Venezia Giulia and Trentino-Alto Adige. The cool, breezy climate is heavily influenced by the Alps, and helps maintain fresh acidity in the wines. Day-night temperature variation develop aromatic intensity.
