**Vineyard Altitude:** 4,429 feet (1350 m.)

**Soil:** Alluvial soil with a rock foundation and top layers of sand-textured earth.

**Viticulture:** Double Guyot, drip irrigation.

**Yield:** 8000 kg/ha.

**Harvest:** April, by hand and in cases of 18 kg.

**Grape Selection:** Double selection at the winery  
(1st selection of grape clusters, 2<sup>nd</sup> selection of berries).

### Tasting Notes

Bright red ruby color. Aromas of raspberry and mild spices, with crisp mineral notes vibrant acidity. In the mouth, it is elegant and well-balanced, with smooth tannins and intense red fruit notes. Pair with poultry, soft cheese, steaks and pork.

### Elaboration Process

The vineyard is located at 4,430 feet high, enjoying a privileged sun exposure and cool temperatures that allow the grapes to have a perfect ripening. The grapes are hand-picked and selected in a sorting table. Temperature controlled fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks.
