Borgo Lame: The simplicity and authenticity of a farming village, through the heady aroma of our wines. Antiche Cantine Borgo Lame rises in the hearth of Piedmont, at Cisterna d'Asti. In this small village, located between Langhe, Roero and Monferrato, with a unique territory, a family of farmers has been patiently working the land for years, by handing down the ancient knowledge of vine cultivation and winemaking to the next generation.

Frè: "A small ancient village, with few houses and a little church. Flipot is the "frè", the smith of the village: he's young but he perfectly knows how to curve the harder iron and how to build tools for the farm and horseshoes. He works with the "ruè" Giacomo, building the wagons. He uses his wagon, in the summer sunset, to go in the vineyards and to go to the mass on Sunday".

Grignolino grape: Produces light-bodied, fruity, and easy drinking wines with lively acidity, earthy and complex notes. Historically, Grignolino grapes fetched prices similar to that of Nebbiolo, but it fell out of favor in the seventies and eighties. Today, Grignolino is enjoying a well-deserved resurgence due to its fresh, fruit forward style, sometimes compared to Beaujolais.

Tasting notes: Light, bright, clean, and fresh. Fruity and spicy aromas, including blackberry, raspberry, strawberry, sage, white pepper, and clove.

Piemonte D.O.C.: Located in the foothills of the Alps forming its border with France and Switzerland. To the northwest is the Valle d'Aosta, to the east is the province of Lombardy with the Liguria region forming its southern border along the Apennines. Piemonte is home to 41 "denominazione di origine controllata" (DOC) and 19 "denominazione di origine controllata e garantita" (DOCG).
