Borgo Lame: The simplicity and authenticity of a farming village, through the heady aroma of our wines. Antiche Cantine Borgo Lame rises in the hearth of Piedmont, at Cisterna d'Asti. In this small village, located between Langhe, Roero and Monferrato, with a unique territory, a family of farmers has been patiently working the land for years, by handing down the ancient knowledge of vine cultivation and winemaking to the next generation.

Giaiet: "A small and ancient village, with few houses and a little church. All around, the vineyards: some of them are very old, with curved and wrinkled shoots, resembling the face of Giaiet, who has the same expression. Every single day he repeats the same gestures among the poles of the old vineyard of Barbera."

Tasting notes: Light, bright, clean, and fresh. Fruity and spicy aromas, including blackberry, raspberry, strawberry, sage, white pepper, and clove.

8 days. Malolactic fermentation at 20°C.

Ageing/Oak: 6 months in stainless-steel tanks.

DOCG Barbera d'Asti: Hilly areas of the Asti and Alessandria provinces in the Piedmont region of Italy. The vineyards are typically situated on hilly terrain, ranging in altitude from 300ft to 1000ft. The region is known for producing medium to full-bodied wines characterized by an intense ruby-red color that graduates towards garnet.
