Bodega Atamisque: Founded in 2002 by John and Chantal Du Monceau, located in Tupungato, at the foothills of the Andes Mountains.

Atamisque's name comes from an aboriginal bush that grows naturally in the region. Respect for the environment and long-term sustainability were the foundation in the construction of Atamisque, such as designing the winery to be based on gravity flow winemaking to avoid the use of pumps and minimize wine stress and utilizing the local slate in the area as tiling for the roof of the buildings providing perfect insulation and temperature control year-round.

Finca Andrea Vineyard: Planted over 90 years ago, this is one of the oldest and most sought-after Malbec vineyards in the world. These vines produce incredible low yields with high concentration of flavors, acidity and tannins.

Tasting notes: Intense purple color and subtle red tones. Ripe and lively aromas and flavors of figs, dried plums, mature strawberries, and blackberries. Lovely notes of coffee, dark chocolate, and tobacco. Smooth and full-bodied mouthfeel with gentle but firm tannins. Vibrant fruit acidity and a beautiful long finish.
