Quinta das Arcas: In 1985 Esteve Montiero decided to turn his successful family business of grape growing into winemaking. Today the Monteiro family is one of the top viticulturists and wine producers in the Vinho Verde and Minho Region, dedicating themselves to producing quality grapes and wines with a focus on sustainability and modern winemaking.

Tasting notes: Young fruity and clean with secondary biscuit aromas from bottle fermentation. Dry with excellent acidity, light body and fine bubbles. Lemon, lychee and peach fruit flavors. Ending with a clean and fresh finish.

Wine Makers: Fernando Machado and Henrique Lopes

Appellation: Vale do Sousa, Vinho Verde region.

Grapes: Azal 50%, Arinto 50%

Soil: Schist

Vine Age: 6 to 20 years, average age

Fermentation: Made using the 'méthode ancestrale'. The wine is fermented in the bottle and the fine lees stay in contact with the wine

with no filtration afterwards.

TA: 6.5 g/l RS: 1.5 g/l Alc: 12% UPC: 5-603238124941



Vale do Sousa: The climate is mild with low temperature amplitudes. This region also sees less rainfall than the other 8 Vinho Verde sub-regions. Although Sousa is not a coastal subregion, the vineyards of Quinta das Arcas are located in the southwestern end of this region at a mere 12.5 miles from the Atlantic. The main varieties are those that do well in a warmer climate; Arinto, Loureiro, Trajudara, Azal and Avesso.
